



The University of Utah Anticonvulsant Drug Development Program is proud to host the inaugural *2015 ADD Program Symposium*, May 17th-20th, 2015 in beautiful Park City, Utah with the overarching theme of “*Therapy Development in the Era of Team Science & Big Data: What Will the Future Bring to the Patient with Epilepsy?*” The symposium will explore how innovative breakthroughs in basic science can be leveraged by public, federal, and private partnerships to rapidly develop new treatments for the patient with epilepsy. **Registration is now open:** www.addsymposium.com.

Travel awards for Junior Investigators (undergraduate/graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, clinical fellows, and junior investigators within 5 years of a terminal degree) will be offered to help defray the cost of attendance, with several speaking sessions reserved for those individuals who submit outstanding abstracts relevant to the session theme. Applicants wishing to be considered for a travel award must submit a relevant abstract and NIH-style biosketch in their online registration. **The deadline for application is March 17th.** Applicants will be notified of award status by April 3rd.

The meeting will be held at the Park City Marriott Hotel in Park City, UT. Located 40 minutes from the Salt Lake International Airport, Park City is a popular year-round tourist destination in the heart of the Wasatch Mountains, with ready access to outdoor activities such as mountain biking, hiking, and fishing.
